## 2011 Partnership Agreement

The Garden Faire is an educational event to raise awareness of the benefits of sustainable gardening and landscaping, such as selecting drought tolerant plants, especially California native plants, and using organic controls in the garden. The Garden Faire will be on June 25, 2011, in Scotts Valley's Skypark.

The California Native Garden Foundation, the host of The Garden Faire 2011, invites non-profit garden- and environment-oriented groups to be the Faire's Partners. Together, we can build our community resources.

### The Faire

- recognizes each Partner in its publicity;
- invites each Partner's input to Faire planning;
- provides each Partner with progress reports; and
- if financially feasible, provides a canopy, table and chairs for a booth at the Faire. (To have a booth, Partners must apply and pay the participation fee.)

### Partners

- endorse sustainable gardening and landscaping;
- endorse the Faire and permit the use of its name in the Faire's publicity;
- distribute Faire promotional materials and calls for volunteers through the Partner's own channels, such as newsletters and web sites.

As separate opportunities, we welcome Partners as exhibitors/vendors and sponsors .

As a Partner of the Faire, your organization will add to its own visibility, bring new ideas and energy to the Faire, and support the Faire's fund-raising efforts.
